2007 ZINFANDEL

WINEMAKER COMMENTS

A Californian classic variety, Zinfandel accurately portrays its terroir through re-creating the very 'rustic' and primitive flavors of the vineyard. Its fruit shows abundant black cherries and liquorice with mouth filling ripe berries and great length of flavor. It is a robust style but still very approachable, not reflecting the variety's propensity for over-ripeness. The palate is a wonderful mixture of ripe berries, black cherry, tobacco and cedar-like oak. The finish is relatively soft permitting the full extent of the flavor spectrum to linger....a fabulous food wine.
